



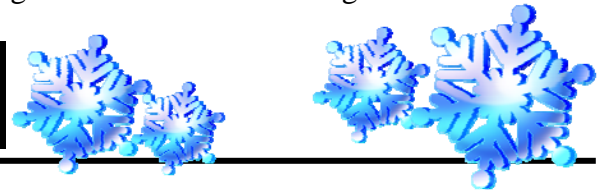

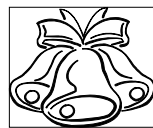
Dear Parents,

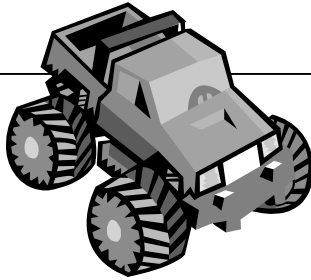
